## **Instructions and information**

You do not have to have a Gila County Health Department Permit to participate in the salsa contest. You will not be allowed to make your food available to the public, it can only be given to and eaten by the Judges.

*If you wish to be a food vendor, you **MUST** use the **Olde Towne Craftsmanship Exposition** form and have a Gila County Health Department Permit.*

1. You must return this completed form and entry fee to the Globe-Miami Regional Chamber of Commerce located at 1360 N. Broad Street, Globe, Arizona 85501, **before June 13, 2026** or you can preregister your entry form(s) by filling it out and emailing it to [CobreValleyID4@gmail.com](mailto:CobreValleyID4@gmail.com) **if you pre-register, you will have to pay your registration fee at the event,**
2. You can have more than one entry however, you will have to fill out a separate entry form and pay the registration fee for each entry. Additional entries must be a different salsa flavor and must have different ingredients, from other entries.
3. Prepare at least 1 cup of **HOME-MADE** salsa in a safe manor,
4. Bring your salsa to Veterans' Memorial Park on Sullivan Street in downtown Miami, Arizona before 8:00 am. You must complete check-in before the end of the parade,
5. Your salsa sample will be stored and kept in an ice chest provided by us,
6. Your entry form will have a random number assigned to it which will be placed on your salsa container,
7. This number will also be written on your sample container that is submitted to the judges, who will conduct a "blind" taste test,
8. Contestant introductions will begin at the end of the Independence Day Parade with judging to begin shortly thereafter,
9. At the end of the contest, winners will be announced, and awards will be given to the winners.
