# INDEPENDENCE DAY PARADE INSTRUCTIONS



**SATURDAY JULY 4, 2026**

1. Setup begins at 7:30 AM. in front of Bullion Plaza. **DO NOT WAIT** for last minute to arrive!
2. Upon arriving, visit **CHECK IN TABLE** located in grass field in front of Bullion Plaza.
3. Volunteers will show you to your place in line. Please follow all their instructions.
4. Be finished decorating on site by 8 AM. Lining up will soon follow.
5. American Legion Motorcycles will pass by at 8:15 AM. Please keep children, pets, animals secure and safe as they pass.
6. Once parade begins, proceed slowly on Sullivan St, following the leader at a safe distance.
7. **STOP** in front of the Announcer tent at the Memorial Park so parade MC can announce your entry. **DO NOT MOVE UNTIL SIGNALLED TO PROCEED.**
8. Proceed **SLOWLY** forward on Sullivan St to allow the entry behind you to be introduced and catch up.
9. Parade route will follow Sullivan Street eastbound to the old YMCA. Use the area to the left (north) of the YMCA building to dismantle before departing.
10. Keep these instructions and bring them with you that morning.
